## WILLARD BAKER PAPERS

### INTRODUCTION:

Willard A. Baker, a resident of Port Washington, NY, was a mechanic for a [Port Washington] Oil Company, and a 59-year member of the Port Washington Fire Department, the Flower Hill Hose Company. He died on October 27, 1996.

### SCOPE AND CONTENT:

Baker's papers include a scrapbook devoted to aviation (ca. 1930-1932), several photographs, cloth patches for the "Vanguard Model Club" and the "Bayport Aerodrome Soc.", and a scarf made from World War II parachute silk.
