Also included are several photos of individuals, an air mail helicopter delivery (1947), programs for the 1935 and 1965 dedications, and two articles by Ernie Simon from the *Port News*. The photographs were taken by Stanley Gerard Mason, Oliver M. Schaeffer, and others.
