## JAMES M. MACKEY ACCOUNTS

### INTRODUCTION:

James Mackey (also spelled MacKay) was a resident of Port Washington, New York who owned a house at 7 Pleasant Avenue during the 1860's and 1870's. The house was torn down sometime around 1979. The papers in this collection were retrieved from the house prior to its demolition.

### SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The collection consists of receipts, accounts, bonds and promissory notes to James and John Mackey dating from 1817 to 1851. The receipts are for goods including foods, household items, dry goods, lumber, and for school tuition and supplies, and cash exchanges. Many of the receipts include the place name "Mosquito Cove" or "Musquito Cove".
