## THE OLANDT FAMILY COLLECTION

### INTRODUCTION:

William H. and Anna Olandt resided with their children at 15 North Maryland Avenue in Port Washington. William Olandt, born in Brooklyn in 1872, was a local purveyor of eggs and butter. He was a member of the Flower Hill Hose Company of the Port Washington Fire Department and an active member of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Port Washington. The Olandts had three children, Helen, John, and William. Helen Olandt (1899-1989) was a life-time resident of Port Washington.

### SCOPE AND CONTENT:

In addition to photographs, there are 28 glass negatives, along with corresponding prints and negatives. Also included is a minute book of the Epworth League of the First Methodist Episcopal Church of Port Washington (1910-1914) and a 1914 Membership Manual of the Methodist Episcopal Church.
